QUICK LINKS: I do recommend reading the ENTIRE document to ensure the most magical time!

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MY DISNEY EXPERIENCE & PLAY APP:

1. As soon as you book, set up your Account on www.mydisneyexperience.com using your reservation number. THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT!!
 - a. Tickets, room reservations, dining reservations & Lightning Lanes will be linked to your account
 - b. Disney is no longer issuing complimentary magic bands. They will have World Cards that you can pick up the hotel upon check in or you can purchase magic bands from the website. If you have old Magic Bands, you can link those one the website and use those as well.
 - i. I also recommend setting up Magic Mobile pass on the app so you can use your phones to get into the parks as well!
 - c. Make dining reservations up to 60 days in advance
 - d. Purchase Disney Genie + each day of your trip (price varies per day). It opens up at midnight to purchase – make sure to purchase BEFORE 7 am.
 - e. Make Lightning Lane reservations starting at 7 am the day of
2. Download the My Disney Experience app to change itinerary selections in real time
 - a. Familiarize yourself with this prior to travel
 - b. You will use this app throughout your vacation to view Disney Genie and Disney Genie + options, alter lightning lane passes, dining reservations, and more!
 - c. PLEASE NOTE: this app uses a LOT of battery so make sure you take a small remote charger so you can charge your phone in your purse.
 - d. This app also shows wait times throughout the park!

3. For younger children: Download the Disney Play App. It has games and fun for the kids to play now, but also has special games that are GPS supported so while you wait in line you have an all new interactive experience including “Playset Party” at the ride Toy Story Mania or “Off to Neverland” at Peter Pan’s Flight and “Rocket Race” at Space Mountain, and “Andy’s Board game Blast” at Slinky Dog Dash. There is also trivia, rewards, challenges, and even allows you to celebrate Disney songs within the app to feature official playlists that are inspired by the theme parks, attractions, and characters! More to come as well!

DISNEY MAGICMOBILE APP

Available now on iPhone and Apple Watch and coming soon to other smart devices, Disney MagicMobile service is a fun, easy-to-use new way for guests to experience The Most Magical Place on Earth. The service is offered in addition to other options such as the MagicBand, the colorful, all-in-one bracelet, which will continue to be available and introduced in even more colors, designs and limited-edition fan favorites into the future.

Here are a few helpful tips to get started with Disney MagicMobile service:

- Create A Customized Digital Pass: Guests can create a Disney MagicMobile pass through the My Disney Experience app and add it to the Wallet app on iPhone or the digital wallet on other smart devices. Guests can customize their pass by choosing from several Disney-themed designs that animate upon use.
- For added ease, they may also store multiple passes on a single device, a great option for families.
- Easily Enter the Parks and More: Guests can simply hold their iPhone, Apple Watch, or other smart device near an access point when entering the parks or using other available features, just like they do with a MagicBand. With Express Mode on iPhone and Apple Watch, guests do not even need to wake or unlock their Apple device, or open up the app, to use their Disney MagicMobile pass. As a reminder, valid park admission/ticket is required for park entry and must be linked to an account.
- Discover Other App Enhancements: We’ve also added a new feature in the My Disney Experience app that allows guests to automatically link their Disney PhotoPass attraction photos and videos to their profile through a smartphone. Just confirm the settings in advance of riding at participating attractions. The My Disney Experience app also enables Disney Resort hotel guests to unlock their room door using our current digital room key feature.
- Guests may use Disney MagicMobile service, a MagicBand or a card interchangeably for added flexibility. Disney Resort hotel guests can purchase MagicBands at a special, pre-arrival price. Guests can also pick up a Key to the World card at their convenience at the front desk.

*Please note Disney MagicMobile service requires iOS 14.4 or later and watchOS 7.3 or later.

- I recommend everyone setting this up just in case.

MAGIC BANDS:

Starting in 2021, Disney is no longer issuing complimentary magic bands. You may pick up your world card at the front desk in lieu of the magic bands. You may purchase magic bands on mydisneyexperience.com if you prefer or use the MagicMobile listed above.

DINING RESERVATIONS

Can be made up to 60 days in advance. 6 am online or by calling Disney Dining at 7 am.

Dining experiences do fill up VERY quickly. However no worries! If you can't get the restaurants you want, keep checking back and don't hesitate to call Disney Dining is 407-939-1947. Generally people make multiple reservations so cancelations are frequent so you can usually get what you want if you stay flexible.

DINING ALERTS: You can set up 6 free alerts for restaurants opening up at

Dining character experiences are made via this way as well. Again keep checking back even on the day of as people cancel. If there is a specific one you want, you can also ask at the hotel upon check in and they may be able to arrange it for you. (MORE INFO BELOW)

DISNEY GENIE + / LIGHTNING LANE

The complimentary Disney Genie service creates your best Disney day inspired by your party's top interests. It also grants you new planning features, including a personalized itinerary creator that seamlessly and smartly maps out your visit with updates that continue from morning to night. And, Disney Genie can even remind you when you're eligible to make dining and activity reservations in advance.

Disney Genie+ Lightning Lane Entrance – This can be purchased the day you are going to the park starting at midnight the day of . Price ranges per day. I HIGHLY recommend purchasing this each day and you will DEFINITELY want to purchase before 7 am as you can start scheduling Lightning Lanes at 7 am. Disney's 2 new Lightning Lane entrances have debuted at a wide variety of attractions and entertainment experiences, and are available through 2 options, which can be combined.

When you take your day to the next level by purchasing Disney Genie+ service, you may choose the next available arrival window for Lightning Lane entrances at select attractions and entertainment. This unique service lets you use our new **Lightning Lane entrance** at select attractions and experiences at the Walt Disney World theme parks. You can make your first selection for the day starting at 7am – I recommend turning off wifi on your phone when you do it, I always find my cell service is faster than the resort's wifi. Once you ride your first selection, you can go into the My Disney Experience app to select your next on and so-on through out the day 😊

Individual Lightning Lane Entrance

For some of our most highly demanded attractions, Lightning Lane entrance access is available to purchase individually. Guests may purchase and select an arrival window one at a time for up to 2 attractions a day. This option is available for all Guests—with or without Disney Genie+ service.

RIDE RECOMMENDATIONS: click here or see below for my personal recommendations for the Rides that you will most likely need to use Lightning Lanes

STAR WAR'S GALAXY EDGE is open! Lightning Lane is accepted for the Millennium Falcon: Smuggler's Run with Disney's Genie +. It is an additional cost for everyone for Rise of the Resistance and HIGHLY recommended. If you are staying off Disney property, you are not able to purchase Smuggler's Run. These are very cool rides. If you are not able to get a lightning lane, make sure to get to the park BEFORE it opens so you are in the queue and as soon as the park opens go as quickly as possible to the line. That is the best chance to ride the ride and it's WORTH THE WAIT!!

Magic Kingdom: (if you do meet and greets with princesses/fairies do that as soon as it opens - generally lines are down and don't need lightning lanes, including Little Mermaid ride. Same with pirates of the Caribbean and almost anything in fantasyland as it is further back) The exception is the Anna/Elsa meet and greet - line is always long.

- TRON: fantastic new ride: virtual queue that is best accessed at 7 am or via purchasing a lighting lane pass (limited though) – See [Tron Section](#)
- Haunted Mansion (love) - definitely need
- Pirates of the Caribbean (love – don't always need, you can usually ride this very easily when park opens up and right after firework show)
- Tinkerbell & fairies (this is a meet and greet w/the fairies)
- Beauty & the Beast (meet and greet but also has interactive story - geared towards younger children) - if you get there early, line is usually short
- Anna & Elsa Meet & Greet
- Seven Dwarfs Mine Train - definitely need (nice roller coaster. – fun for all – even ones who don't normally ride roller coasters!)
- Peter Pan's Flight - definitely need (this is cool - kids loved it and you can all do it)
- It's a small world
- Space mountain- definitely need (this is for 8ish on up – check height requirements on app)
- Splash Mountain (great log flume ride)

Hollywood Studios:

- Toy Story Mania- definitely need
- Star Wars – (view info below)
- Tower of Terror
- Aerosmith's Rock N Roller Coaster - definitely need
- Slinky Dog Dash Roller Coaster - definitely need
- Alien Swirling Saucers

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Animal Kingdom:

- Both Avatar Rides- definitely need! There is one for everyone and one with a height restriction. (adult favorites too!)
- Expedition Everest - (this is for 8ish on up, check height requirements)
- Safari
- Kali River Rapids - not for babies but fun for kids of most ages - will get wet - if you get here earlier, usually line is shorter.

Epcot:

- Frozen Ever After – very cute ride
- Soarin - can be scary for children 6ish and under
- Test Track - for older people
- Spaceship Earth (if you get there early you can usually walk on)
- Guardians of the Galaxy (Refer to that section – AMAZING!)

ONLINE CHECK IN: To expedite your check in process:

Check in online (via My Disney Experience account) for your resort up to 60 days prior to arrival on My Disney Experience Website so you can avoid the front desk altogether!

Disney can even email/text you when your room is ready!

MOBILE FOOD ORDERING

Disney allows you to preorder and prepay for your food at participating Counter Service restaurants. Upon arrival at the restaurant, guests using Mobile Order can then bypass the ordering queue and go straight to a designated Pick Up Counter to get their food. Just open up the My Disney experience app, under the My plans, select Order Food. Then select your restaurant and check out the menu and build your order. ☺

Once you customize and purchase and arrive at the restaurant, simply open your My Disney Experience app and touch the screen option that announces your arrival. The order will enter into preparation once you hit the "I'm Here" option upon your arrival at the restaurant. You'll receive a notification on where to pick up your order once the screen displays your order is ready. A nice feature is you aren't tied to a specific time to pick up your meal. ☺ A time saver for sure!

RIDER SWITCH:

Adults can ride big rides even if the kids won't. Disney has a system called Rider Switch that will allow the older members of your family to ride while the too-little-to-ride members wait. You simply tell the Cast Member at any ride that has a height requirement that you'd like to do a Rider Switch.

They'll give you a Rider Switch pass (which works like a FastPass) so that after you ride, you can hand it to the other half of your party and they can ride right away without waiting in line. Another perk: if you have a child that wants to ride and one that doesn't, the child that wants to ride can actually go twice - once with each parent.

MAPS:

Below is a link to a map of the entire Walt Disney World property. The map includes all the Disney Theme Parks, Resorts, Water Parks, & Disney Springs. You can scroll in and out of the map to get as much, or as little, detail as you wish. This will give you a good idea as to where things are in proximity to one another. Just remember, you're never going to be close to everything! (also maps are available on the apps)

Download the My Disney Experience app on your smartphone. It will be your best friend while you are in Disney! Plus, it has a great feature that lists the wait times for EVERY ride, which is very useful.

SAFETY

Make a copy, or take a picture with your phone, of your ID, important documents, and any credit cards you may bring with you. This is to ensure that you have the telephone numbers and other information needed to report a lost or stolen card.

Each morning take a picture of your child/children. This is in case you get separated or lost from one another. You then have a photograph with what they look like and what they are wearing that day.

STROLLERS:

I recommend bringing your own so it doesn't look like everyone else's.

However Single-day and multi-day stroller rentals are available at all Disney Theme Parks. Look for the stroller symbol on each Disney Theme Park Guidemap, available at the Park entrances. Strollers cannot be pre-rented from the park.

You can also rent from outside companies such as <https://www.orlandostrollerrentals.com/> (Beach Bum Vacation does not endorse this company specifically, but overall this company does get good reviews online.)

TRANSPORTATION WITHIN DISNEY

You can take a bus, boat or monorail from any resort to any theme park, but to get from resort to resort you have to go to the Transportation & Ticket Center and transfer there.

The Resort Monorail makes the following stops:

- Magic Kingdom Theme Park
- Disney's Contemporary Resort
- Transportation and Ticket Center (TTC)
- Disney's Polynesian Village Resort
- Disney's Grand Floridian Resort & Spa

The Epcot Monorail and the Express Monorail originate at the TTC and offer express round-trip service to Epcot & Magic Kingdom Theme Park.

The Walt Disney World Monorail System operates from 30 minutes prior to earliest park opening until one hour after latest park closing. Keep in mind that certain destinations are not direct; you may be required to take a connecting mode of transportation to reach your destination.

Disney also has partnered with Lyft with their "Minnie Vans" which you can schedule a pick up from anywhere within Disney and request a ride and pay through the Lyft app.

CHILD CARE/BABY CARE CENTERS

There are childcare centers near the entrance of each park for younger kids should they need to rest or just need a quiet place to decompress. Also, Baby Care Centers can be found in all Disney Theme Parks and offer private rooms with rocking chairs for nursing mothers, diaper-changing rooms and rooms with highchairs. Diapers, formula, and teethingers are available for purchase. Look for the pacifier symbol on each Disney Theme Park Guidemap, available at the Park entrances.

DISNEY'S MEMORY MAKER: Great way to get an unlimited number of family photos without 1 person missing in the picture. I highly recommend it. I loved having all the family pics that I normally would not have gotten. I think of the cost like a family photo sitting fee. ☺ If interested, I can add it on to your package.

There are Disney photographers around the park to take family pictures, Walt Disney World also has 3 locations with a studio backdrop: Marketplace @ Disney Springs, Sir Mickey's @ Magic Kingdom Park, and on the 2nd floor of Disney's Grand Floridian Resort & Spa. They offer the opportunity to capture photos in front of a standard backdrop or Disney themed virtual backdrops.

PACKING

If you are flying to Orlando, pack in your carry-on a bathing suit and one outfit per person. Depending on when you arrive at Disney, it may take a few hours until your room is ready. This way you can still go swimming if you want, or change your clothes after the plane ride. The resort can hold your luggage until your room is available.

For the younger girls, if they are going to do Bibbidi Bobbidi Boutique in the Magic Kingdom or Disney Springs, bring a Princess dress instead of purchasing it at Disney. Again, it's more expensive to buy it there than at local stores. Even if they aren't participating in the boutique, I know from experience that little girls like to dress up as their favorite princess and walk around the parks in them. This also goes for any buccaneers or Jedi's out there!

Don't forget your sunscreen, and then don't forget to reapply if you are sweating in the summer.

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If you want, purchase hand-held spray fans to help keep cool during the hot & humid summer months. They're \$20 if you buy them there.

Don't forget to bring sweatshirts or sweat jackets for cool evenings in the fall and winter. Sweatshirts in the parks are expensive! – check the weather first.

Bring a portable cell phone charger. The Disney App will eat up your battery.

RAIN RAIN GO AWAY

Buy rain ponchos **before** you leave to bring with you. There can be brief, but drenching thunderstorms that you don't want to be caught in. Plus, the parks don't close in the event of rain, though some individual rides may. Rain ponchos at the park are VERY expensive!

TIPS:

DO NOT go into attractions with long running times without taking kids for a bathroom break first!

If a wait time is 20 minutes or less I recommend NOT using lightning lanes.

Buy Disney-themed souvenirs ahead of time for your kids (from Target, Amazon, Dollar Tree, etc.) and package them up for your trip. If you want, in the middle of the night, leave a souvenir by each kid's bed (kind of like the concept of a Disney tooth-fairy) with a note from Mickey Mouse, or another Disney character, telling them to have a wonderful day at the Magic Kingdom, or whatever park you're visiting that day. It adds a little Disney magic. Hopefully, your child won't feel the need to buy souvenirs that day because they got a gift from Mickey himself, AND you don't spend a fortune on Disney souvenirs!

You may find using gift cards instead of cash much easier. You can get your kids a gift card of their own and set a spending limit for souvenirs. Keep the card number/receipt because if it is lost, it can be reported to Disney and they will check the account. You then can be given a new card with the remaining balance. Better than losing cash or losing your credit cards! – Many schools offer a fund raising program called Scrip – great way to purchase gift cards for Disney and raise money for your school!

There are now places to charge your cell phone in several of the parks.

The average day is 7 miles of walking! Be sure to wear comfortable shoes.

Disney allows you to visit all their resorts for free, just to hang out and see what the property looks like, though you can't use the pool. This is a great way to spend an afternoon when you don't have tickets, and especially during the holidays when everything is decorated. You can enjoy a meal while you are there too.

If you can, do not buy overpriced bottled water in the parks. Invest in a refillable water bottle or have a case of water delivered to your room on the first day of your arrival. Garden Grocer (<https://www.gardengrocer.com/>),

Below is a list of the Character Dining restaurants along with the Disney friends that appear at each dining establishment. Except for Cinderella's Royal Table, all the restaurants are buffet style dining. **Please note that character appearances are subject to change without notice.**

1900 Park Fare in Disney's Grand Floridian - Mary Poppins, Alice in Wonderland, The Mad Hatter, Tigger, and Winnie the Pooh appear at this restaurant for breakfast. At dinner, Cinderella, Prince Charming, and their friends join in on the fun.

Epcot International Festival of the Holidays – Candlelight Processional Dining Packages:

The popular [Candlelight Processional](#) features a celebrity narrator, 50-piece orchestra and glorious massed choir—but this enchanting seasonal spectacular tends to fill up quickly! By reserving a Candlelight Processional Dining Package, you'll be able to indulge in a leisurely holiday meal with loved ones, plus have peace of mind knowing that seating is guaranteed at this highly sought-after Christmastime event.

Candlelight Processional Dining Packages are available for breakfast, lunch and dinner—each meal includes an appetizer, entrée and dessert or one full buffet (where applicable), along with a non-alcoholic beverage. Simply select a restaurant, savor the sumptuous cuisine, then take your seat—the sights and sounds of this joy-filled family tradition are sure to lift spirits!

STAR WARS GALAXY'S EDGE- WHAT TO DO

Star Wars Galaxy's Edge opened in the fall 2019. You enter the land of Batuu and have your own intergalactic experience! Batuu has always existed in Star Wars films, but it was never shown. The creators chose this land so that you can create your own immersive experience in the galaxy!

Millennium Falcon: Smuggler's Run does accept lightning lane passes, but they can be difficult to get. You want to try for one right at 7 am the day of. Regardless arrive when the park opens and go straight to the rides for the best chance to get on them and enjoy the wonder of Batuu. I would even recommend arriving before the park opens.

Star Wars: Rise of the Resistance, is the banner attraction and has 4 ride systems, 2 ships, and a battalion of Stormtroopers and multiple Kylo Ren encounters! It's unlike any other attraction that exists – completely immersive! Very cool!! It is an additional cost for everyone to get a lightning lane pass and HIGHLY recommended. If you are staying off Disney property, you are not able to purchase Smuggler's Run. If you are not able to get a lightning lane, make sure to get to the park BEFORE it opens so you are in the queue and as soon as the park opens go as quickly as possible to the line. That is the best chance to ride the ride and it's WORTH THE WAIT!!

Other than the rides, guests are encouraged to explore the very authentic land of Batuu and interact with the locals as they all have their own stories.

Food is of course an always important part of traveling so be sure to check out the local restaurants from Kat Saka's Kettle popcorn stand, drinks at Oga's Cantina which even has its own droid, wraps and snacks at Ronto Roasters, and unique offerings at the Docking Bay.

How to enter the virtual queue

Beginning at 7 a.m. guests with a valid ticket for that day will be able to check for an available boarding group via the My Disney Experience app* and request access to the virtual queue. This can be done before clients leave their Resort hotel or on the way to the park. I recommend turning off wifi on your phone when you do it, I always find my cell service is faster than the resort's wifi. Make sure you are on your phone before 7 am so right at 7 am you click "Enter Virtual Queue".

At 1 p.m., there will be another opportunity to join the virtual queue for anyone who wasn't able to join a boarding group earlier in the day. Keep in mind, Clients must be inside EPCOT to access this second virtual queue opportunity.

In order to give as many guests as possible the opportunity to save the galaxy, each person can enter the virtual queue no more than once per day during regular park hours. Please note that joining the virtual queue does not guarantee the ability to experience Guardians of the Galaxy: Cosmic Rewind.

Virtual queue during extended evening hours

Registered guests staying at a Disney Deluxe Resort, Disney Deluxe Villa Resort or other select hotels will have an additional opportunity to request to join the virtual queue at 6 p.m. on select dates during extended evening theme park hours. Guests with this benefit do not need to be in EPCOT to request to join at that time.

Guests will need valid admission for the same park on the same day to experience extended evening hours — or, guests may experience extended evening hours if they have a ticket or annual pass with the Park Hopper option.

How to purchase individual Lightning Lane entry

Clients with valid park admission can purchase individual Lightning Lane entry in the My Disney Experience app* via the Disney Genie service on the same day of their visit, subject to availability.

Virtual queue and individual Lightning Lane entry are only accessible via the My Disney Experience app*. If clients have questions or need assistance registering for virtual queue or purchasing an individual Lightning Lane entry, look for one of the Guest Experience Team Cast Members throughout the park, who will be happy to assist.

How to download and share attraction photos

After experiencing Guardians of the Galaxy: Cosmic Rewind, don't forget about the attraction photo! There will be two options to automatically link the attraction photo to a My Disney Experience account:

- Enable Bluetooth® on a mobile device for the My Disney Experience app* before riding. Log in to the app sometime earlier that day, and keep the device out of low power mode. Then, just keep the device in a pocket or bag while enjoying the ride.*
- Wear a MagicBand that is linked to a My Disney Experience account.

TRON

1. JOIN TEAM BLUE VIA THE VIRTUAL QUEUE

When TRON Lightcycle / Run opens it will use a virtual queue, allowing guests the opportunity to experience the attraction later in the day and enjoy all that Magic Kingdom Park has to offer while they wait to enter the Grid. Guests with a valid ticket for the date they would like to request to join the virtual queue via the My Disney Experience app*. A standby queue will not be available.

2. INDIVIDUAL LIGHTNING LANE ENTRY

Guests may also have the option to purchase individual – or à la carte – Lightning Lane entry in the My Disney Experience app*. On the day of their visit, Team Blue recruits with valid admission on the same date may visit the Disney Genie Service Tip Board in the app to choose an arrival window and make their purchase before joining the high-speed race against Team Orange. Guests may check the app on the day of their visit for pricing and availability.

3. NEW LOCKER SYSTEM

New to TRON Lightcycle / Run, a double-sided and digitized locker system will be used to store bags and loose items while guests race their Lightcycle. Inside the attraction queue, these complimentary lockers pair directly with MagicBand, MagicBand+ or ticket media so guests can easily lock and reopen their locker with a quick tap. Guests without a MagicBand or other ticket media (such as a card) will be provided with a card to assign their locker. All items must be placed either in a locker before guests board their Lightcycle, or in a small compartment located on the attraction vehicle that can hold items such as cellphones, glasses or wallets.

4. DISNEY PHOTOPASS PHOTO AND VIDEO OFFERINGS

Guests can relive their race through this dark, computerized world when they preview an onboard photo and video automatically linked to their My Disney Experience account through one of the following methods:

- Use an eligible mobile device, enable Bluetooth® for the My Disney Experience app* before riding, make sure to be logged into the My Disney Experience app* sometime earlier that day, and keep the

device out of low power mode. Make sure the mobile device boards the Lightcycle with the Guest and is safely stored in the small Lightcycle compartment to use this method.

- Wear a MagicBand or MagicBand+ that's linked to a My Disney Experience account.
